# **Learning and Teaching**

As part of developing a broad, general education (BGE) in S1-S3, we expect pupils to continue to work hard across a wide range of subjects. As pupils become more knowledgeable about each subject, their overall subject preferences will develop.

During second year, parents and pupils will have various opportunities to discuss options for individual course choices for the year ahead and be given more information in preparation for the Senior Phase (S4-S6).

Our pupils' knowledge and skills base is developing quickly in Second year. It is important that pupils reinforce what they are learning through structured homework and revision at home. This will enable them to build a strong platform on which to build for future learning, as pace and challenge increases.

Parents can help enormously by regularly discussing subjects with their children and routinely checking and commenting on their classwork and homework. Giving pupils the opportunity to explain what they are learning and asking questions helps them to deepen their own understanding and retention.
