MINUTES

P Anderson opened the meeting and welcomed everyone in T Pupillo's absence.

- -S Molley distributed copies of minutes from the previous meeting for approval, along with a copy of the School Fund financial statement to the committee.
- -M Eggington was welcomed as a new member to the committee

The committee discussed action points and minutes from previous meeting.

The outstanding balance of 'Spirit of Scone' Trip has now been paid by the general fund. A spelling error was highlighted of 'Spirit of School' which should read 'Spirit of Scone' in the minutes.

S Molley informed the committee of the criteria for spending the donation from the Hunter Foundation. It was agreed that the donation should go into the hardship fund.

An agreed amount of money was moved from the School Lockers fund into the general fund.

P Anderson informed the committee that T Pupillo is continuing to look into the funding of a pupil's 'cost of a school day'. This is to be carried over to next meeting for discussion.

G Kirk has now sent out a clarifying email that in future all pupils are to pay directly online to UCAS.

The outstanding balance of the STEM fund has been transferred into the general school fund.

Parents have been invited to pay a one-off cost for all non-uniform days for the year by ParentPay which has been a success.

The outstanding balance of several trips have now been paid by a combination of money from the general and hardship fund as agreed at previous meeting.
